DIRECTIONS TO JIMMY BROUGHT FITNESS CENTER: 2404 N. NEW BRAUNFELS AVE, FORT SAM HOUSTON, 78234 (ON FORT SAM HOUSTON)

TRAVELING I35 SOUTH INTO SAN ANTONIO, EXIT WALTERS STREET. IT IS THE EXIT AFTER THE **SBC** EXIT. TURN RIGHT ONTO WALTERS STREET, YOU WILL BE HEADING WEST ONTO THE ARMY BASE.

TRAVELING I35 NORTH INTO SAN ANTONIO, EXIT WALTERS STREET. IT IS THE EXIT AFTER NEW BRAUNFELS AVE. TURN LEFT ONTO WALTERS STREET YOU WILL BE HEADING WEST ONTO THE ARMY BASE.

YOU WILL NEED TO STAY IN THE VISITORS LANE FAR RIGHT TO GAIN A PASS. **PLEASE HAVE YOUR REGISTRATION UP TO DATE AND YOUR INSURANCE FOR YOUR VEHICLE. ALL PERSONNEL OVER THE AGE OF 16 MUST HAVE VALID IDENTIFICATION.**

(TELL THEM YOU ARE ATTENDING THE MAYB TOURNAMENT HELD BY LT PICHON.)

THE SECURITY GUARDS WILL DIRECT YOU OUT OF THE VISITOR'S AREA TO WILSON ROAD. TURN LEFT ON WILSON ROAD AND PASS THE STOP LIGHT. JIMMY BROUGHT FITNESS CENTER IS TWO BLOCKS ON THE RIGHT AFTER THE GAS STATION. (YOU WILL BE ABLE TO SEE THE GAS STATION FROM THE VISITORS AREA. ON THE MAP YOU WILL SEE SQUARE SHAPES FACING EACH OTHER; THAT IS THE APPROXIMATE LOCATION OF THE JIMMY BROUGHT FITNESS CENTER.

STAY ON THAT ROAD, **YOU WILL BE PASSING THE GOLF COURSE AND CEMETARY.** AT THE END OF THAT ROAD TAKE A RIGHT (YOU CAN ONLY GO LEFT OR RIGHT) TO THE LEFT YOU WILL BE LEAVING THE BASE TO HARRY WURZBACH, **TURN RIGHT AND THEN THE FIRST LEFT WILL TAKE YOU TO THE YOUTH CENTER. TRAVELING I35 SOUTH AND 135 NORTH INTO SAN ANTONIO. TAKE THE 410 WEST EXIT ABOUT 3 MILES; EXIT HARRY WURZBACH. TURN LEFT ONTO HARRY WURZBACH. YOU WILL TRAVEL APPROXIMATELY 5 MILES ON HARRY WURZBACH. TURN LEFT ON WINANS; THIS IS THE ENTRANCE TO FORT SAM HOUSTON. TAKE THE FIRST LEFT AFTER THE STOP SIGN TO GET TO THE YOUTH CENTER. COLE HS IS DIRECTLY STRAIGHT AT THE END OF THE ROAD TO THE LEFT.
