#### Directions to Grand Junction and Colorado Mesa University:

Grand Junction is located in Western Colorado, approx. 25 miles from the Utah border, along Interstate 70. Colorado Mesa University is located in the heart of the city at: 1100 North Avenue.

#### From Denver (From the East)

Go west on Interstate 70. Exit at the Horizon Street exit (Exit 31) and turn left at the stop light. Continue to the roundabout and take the third exit to North 12th Street.

#### From Salt Lake City (From the West)

Take Interstate 15 south to Exit 258 (US 6). Take US 6 to Interstate 70. Enter Interstate 70 east towards Colorado. Exit at the Horizon Street exit (Exit 31) and turn right at the stop light. Continue to the roundabout and take the third exit to North 12th Street.

#### From Montrose/Durango (From the South)

Take US 550 North through the mountains. In Montrose, continue north. US 550 changes to US 50. This continues into Grand Junction.

Note: Always check with the Colorado Department of Transportation website before traveling across any mountain pass.

## Parking:

## Mid America Youth Basketball Winter Tournament Regulations & Guidelines

- 1. All teams are guaranteed a minimum of 3 scheduled games. When possible, teams will be abilitygrouped after pool play and brackets will be played out.
- 2. Regulation High School Activities Association rules will be followed with the following exceptions:
  - a. 20 minute running clock except for the last 2 minutes of each half, unless one team is ahead by 15 points or more. In addition, the clock will stop on all technical fouls. Clock does not restart until it would in a normal dead ball situation.
  - b. Teams are not allowed to press over half court with a 20 point or more lead. The first violation will be a warning, if it continues a technical foul may be assessed to the bench if the officials deem it intentional.
  - c. 4th –6th boys will use girl's size ball. 7th grade boys will use the ball size of the state they are playing in. 8th grade boys will use the ball size required by the High School Activities Association of the State that the tournament is in.
  - d. 5-minute half time and 5 minute pre-game warm-up.
  - e. Game time is forfeit time.
  - f. Jerseys need only have a number on the back with no number restrictions.
  - g. 4 time-outs per game, no 20-second time-outs.
  - h. 3rd Grade teams will play on 8 ½ foot goals.
- 3. No locker rooms, balls & etc...will be provided by the schools.
- 4. Individual awards for 1st and 2nd place in each age group.
- 5. Players may play on only 1 team within a tournament age group. Players eligibility will be checked by a current grade card, if requested. Players may play "up" in an older age group. This could mean a player plays in the 5<sup>th</sup> grade tournament and in the 6<sup>th</sup> grade tournament. But they cannot play on 2 teams in the same 6<sup>th</sup> grade tournament.
- 6. All games will be officiated by high school certified officials.
- 7. Inappropriate behavior will not be tolerated!!! A referee may remove players from the game or tournament for inappropriate behavior. We are here for the kids. Do not allow or condone poor sportsmanship. This includes coaches and parents!!!
- 8. Referee may stop clock within reason. Intentionally wasting time to shorten the game can be punished by a technical foul. This does not mean a team cannot use a delay offense at anytime they choose.
- 9. Each tournament site will have a supervisor. Please direct all questions, comments, or concerns to this individual.
- 10. No food or drinks are allowed in tournament facilities, unless noted otherwise.
- 11. Tiebreaker procedure is as follows. 1st criteria is head to head competition. If a 3 way tie exists and there is no head to head winner, a coin flip will be used to determine seeding. If the tournament is a "Round Robin" tournament, a point differential system will go in effect at the director's discretion. Margin of victory up to a 15-point max per game will be used to determine final placing if there are no brackets.
- 12. Overtimes will be 2 minutes in length with regular clock operation. The clock stops on all dead balls. 1 additional time-out for each overtime.
- 13. All roster changes should be made to the National Office in writing at least 48 hours before the start of the tournament. The roster you list in your scorebook for the first game of each tournament is your roster for the weekend. Make sure to include on this list any player who for any reason is not playing the first game, but intends to play following games.
- 14. Each team needs to provide a clock operator or score keeper for each game.
- 15. If you need motel lists and playing sites, call 800-509-5721.
- 16. Our first and primary goal remains to give all players maximum court time to improve their game in a competitive setting.
