### What NOT to bring to P2P Sports Basketball Events

-No individual or team basketballs are allowed. We provide the warm-up and game balls. If someone/team brings, we ask they are left in their vehicle, or we will keep at front entry until the event is over. No outside food is allowed. Per rental agreements with school districts, and at the Event Center in Colorado, cleanliness and upkeep a priority, thus the guideline. Anger, bad attitude, or poor sportsmanship. It's easily seen, and we ask that you leave them at home, preferably on a leash. 😊

### Refund Policy

We do not schedule teams who are not paid prior to scheduling. Once a schedule has started, no refunds are issued. If we are able to find a team willing to pay full price for the spot vacated, we will issue a refund. No credits for future events can be used for a team forfeiting their games after scheduling has been done.

### Coaches Guidelines

Voice of the team, and all conduct issues are responsibility.  
Only 2 coaches per team allowed on the bench  
Only rostered players allowed on the team bench. No children/siblings  
2 technical fouls direct or indirect from asst. coach (1 game suspension)  
3 technical fouls from entire team in game results in forfeit of game  
Not allowed to approach an official anytime or anywhere outside game-time

### Player Guidelines

No player is allowed to play on two teams in the same grade level  
Players competing on a team not listed on roster, results in suspension  
Two technical fouls result in 1 game suspension  
Players are not allowed to join a game that is already in progress. If late, or coming from another grade level, if the game has already started, they must wait until the next game for that team begins.  
Not allowed to approach officials at any time or place.

### Parent/Spectator Guidelines

Not allowed in team bench area.

Any verbal or physical actions resulting in the game being stopped results in warning and or removal from event. If removal, the player(s) associated may be removed from the event.

Not allowed to approach officials at any time.

Issues are directed to head coach, who then informs staff.

Any issues/concerns must be in written form, submitted to [info@powertoplaysports.com](mailto:info@powertoplaysports.com). There must be written documentation in order for concern to be addressed.

### Roster Guidelines

Players are not allowed to play on two teams in the same grade level, regardless of Tier level.

Must be submitted in advance before the tournament

Cannot add players at any time during the day or from one day to the next.

False information provided on roster (grade level, etc) results in suspension.

Unsigned seniors are allowed to participate in tournament or league play.

### Spectator Admissions

Spectator admissions is required. We are a private entity, with no local, regional, or federal tax dollar assistance, and are required to pay local, regional and federal taxes. While we explore options of including the spectator admissions into the pricing of our Events, the management of this aspect is yet to be determined, and logistics not easily-attained.

Spectator admission is not sold on location. All must be done prior, through our BOX OFFICE. Tickets purchased are sent to email and/or phone via text. When showing up for an event, you will show your ID and your ticket. Wristbands are then issues for daily or weekend passes.

### Accountability/Sportsmanship

Spectator/Coach/Player Code of Conduct is the single most difficult aspect of youth, travel clubs to manage, and hold accountable.

P2P Sports has a no-tolerance policy. Any verbal or physical actions escalating, results in our right to remove individuals, coaching staff, and/or the entire team immediately.

### Live-Stream Services

All games/conduct is video-taped on location. P2P Sports features 12 cameras throughout the inside of the building, and additional exterior. All concerns, personal incidents are reviewed, and when needed, provided to police authorities as requested.

Sites used outside P2P Sports, we use the school resources to obtain video footage if needed. When staff is available, games will be hosted via live-stream.

Live-stream on game day is PAY-PER-VIEW

Live-stream records, are FREE the day after events take place.

### Teams traveling to P2P Sports (in Colorado) for events

If arriving the night before an event, FREE shoot-around time is provided for out of state and regional teams. Email [alison@powertoplaysports.com](mailto:alison@powertoplaysports.com) for consideration. Regional events hosted outside P2P Sports in Colorado, shoot-around times are not available.

### Scorer's Table Operations

P2P Sports provides all staff to manage the scorer's table and clock operations. These people are paid as independent contractors. To be considered for these positions, email [brucebird@powertoplaysports.com](mailto:brucebird@powertoplaysports.com)

### Officials

P2P Sports pays officials from \$25-35.00 per official per game. Background check approved, and certification pending and/or approved, hired and managed by Bruce Bird and Lloyd Martinez. To become an official, contact [brucebird@powertoplaysports.com](mailto:brucebird@powertoplaysports.com).

### Games/Scheduling

Games are played on gyms with only high school regulations. No short courts are used (side/side high school gyms). If a court is not full-sized, we will not allow our games to be played.

We do not provide free entries to teams to fill a division. It is unfair to paying teams to offer this, and ultimately, we would rather refund an entry than provide a division with teams not paying the same amount to participate.

In league play, schedules are set week to week. Teams finishing with the same records the week prior, example, 2-0, 1-1, and 0-2 are scheduled against each other the following week. It provides competitive games week to week. All games are scheduled manually to assist in special requests, travel needs, etc.

### Schedules and results.

### Grade Level/Registration

P2P Sports follows school grade level for registration.

September 1-May 31, teams are to register in the grade level of their oldest player during that current school year.

June 1-August 31, teams are to register in the grade level of their oldest player during the NEXT SCHOOL YEAR they will enter in the FALL SEASON. For example, if your team just finished the 6<sup>th</sup> grade, during the summer (as of June 1), you register for the next grade level. You are no longer considered in the 6<sup>th</sup> grade once the summer season has started. You are now considered a 7<sup>th</sup> grader.

### Tier level descriptions

Tier I: advanced, travel team, bigger, stronger, and prior success in events. Sometimes suggested to play up a grade level if your goal is to get competition.

Tier II: Intermediate, average size and skills/success in events. Usually the best for your team to play in the actual grade level of your team.

Tier III: Lower level, beginner, novice skill, size, and experience. At times, appropriate to play down a grade level to gain confidence and experience, without being intimidated by the travel club environment. Consent to play down must be approved prior by P2P Staff.

## PLAYING RULES

Games are available VIA LIVE-STREAM

Teams and players DO NOT BRING THEIR OWN BASKETBALLS.

All warm-up and game balls will be provided by P2P Sports  
Please no outside food, coolers. (help keep our gyms/event center clean)

Only roster players are allowed on the bench.

Only the head coach and assistant coach are allowed on the bench.

P2P Sports provides the scorer's table operations.

All games will be available pay-per-view live stream

Any team receiving 3 technical fouls in a game, results in forfeit and 1 game suspension for the head coach

Any player or coach receiving 2 technical fouls in a game, results in 1 game suspension

Officials Assigned by Bruce Bird and Lloyd Martinez

**A no press rule is in effect for 15 points. If your team is up by 15 points, you are allowed to pick up the offense at ½ court. No full court press/defense is allowed until the point differential is 14 points or below, when you are then allowed to press again until it goes to 15 points again.**

State High School League Rules, with the following exceptions:

1. Warm-ups (4 minutes), Half-times (3 minutes)
2. Two, 20-minute halves (clock runs continuous). Clock stops last 1 minute of 1<sup>st</sup> half, and last 2 minutes of 2<sup>nd</sup> half with point differential 9 points or less.
3. Overtime: 1<sup>st</sup> (2 minutes stopped time), 2<sup>nd</sup> (first team to score 2 points)
4. Team bench area for players and coaches on roster allowed. No exceptions, and any violation of parents or fans entering the area is disqualification from Event Center for that date of game.
5. All Offenses and defenses are allowed in tournament play
6. 3 time-outs per team, per game, do not carry into OT. One additional timeout provided for OT (no additional if goes into 2<sup>nd</sup> OT)
7. Technical fouls are NOT AWARDED FREE THROWS. 2 points awarded to the opposing team, and opposing team receives ball sideline out of bounds
